 - B. James 3:1-12 The tongue is very powerful
 - C. Proverbs 10:19 We should not use it as much
 - D. Matthew 12:34-36 out of the heart proceeds out of the mouth
 - E. Col. 4:6 must be with grace seasoned with salt
- III. Are we preparing our thoughts to be weighed?
 - A. Heb. 4:13 everything is open to God
 1. Psalm 44:21 God knows our thoughts
 2. Matt 9:4
 - B. Matthew 15:19 the thoughts in our hearts defile us
 1. Luke 6:45 good hearts or bad hearts
 2. Matthew 5:21-28
 3. Hebrews 4:12 The word discerns the thoughts of our heart
